

DAY 21 – DOMINION THROUGH WORSHIP

Scripture

2 Chronicles 20:22

"When they began to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes."

Meditation

Worship is warfare. Praise shifts battles into God's hands and turns our focus from the size of the problem to the greatness of God.

When Jehoshaphat and the people began to sing and praise, the Lord intervened on their behalf. Worship does not mean that challenges are ignored; it means we choose to trust God in the middle of them.

When you worship, you declare that God is greater than the battle before you. Praise strengthens your faith, shifts your perspective, and invites you to depend on God's power rather than your own strength.

Reflection

Worship invites divine intervention.

What battle or difficult situation can you place into God's hands today through sincere worship and praise?

Confession

My praise releases God's power. I trust God in every battle, and I win battles through worship. My heart is fixed on Him, and my praise declares His greatness and faithfulness.
