

DAY 6 – AUTHORITY IN THE WORD

Scripture

Luke 4:32

"His word was with authority."

Meditation

The Word of God carries divine authority and power. When Jesus spoke, people recognized that His words were different—they carried authority. As believers, we are called to trust God's Word, speak it in faith, and allow it to shape how we respond to circumstances.

When we speak God's Word with faith, we are not expressing our personal opinions or relying on human strength. We are agreeing with what God has already said. His Word becomes the foundation of our prayers, declarations, decisions, and actions.

Authority begins with agreement with God. The more we know His Word, believe His promises, and speak according to His truth, the more confidently we can stand in the authority He has given us through Christ.

Reflection

Speak the Word as law, not as opinion.

Are your words today agreeing more with God's Word or with what your circumstances are telling you?

Confession

God's Word in my mouth carries authority. I speak His Word with faith and confidence. I decree according to His truth, and I stand firmly on His promises. God's Word is established in my life, and I walk in the authority of His truth.
